The hand-held stock management reader has been designed to allow staff to read smart label-equipped items (books, DVDs and CDs), whilst stored on the shelf, and process the information from the label to provide a full inventory or help to locate items.

The reader features a large flexible antenna that is designed to flex around the books as it is moved down the shelf edge, providing maximum reading capability. Information relating to the current task is displayed using a large touchscreen interface, with notifications provided optionally via audible alerts, LED light, vibration or a combination of all three.

The reader is equipped with the following functionality:

Search and seek

The reader can be used to search for a particular item on a shelf using a variety of criteria. For example, items that have not been loaned within a given period, exact book titles, search by author, etc.

Shelf tidying and cataloguing

By downloading zone information to the reader, it can be configured to report on items that are out of place, allowing an operator to immediately remove the items and re-shelf.

Item inventory

For stock counting and inventory purposes, the reader can be configured to simply read all item identification numbers and store as a list for downloading. This function provides the operator with a complete inventory of all items.

Connectivity

The power of the hand-held comes from the unique way in which it interfaces with existing Library Management Systems (LMS) using standard protocols, allowing particular search patterns to be generated automatically and without duplication of information.
